LEGAL CAPACITY TO CONTRACT MARRIAGE

The Philippine Embassy issues a legal capacity for Filipinos intending to enter into marriage in Lao PDR. This certification affirms that there are no legal impediments to the applicant's marriage (e.g. if the applicant is already married to someone else).

The following are the requirements

1. Personal appearance of the applicant
2. Accomplished Affidavit for the Application for a Certificate of Legal Capacity to Contract Marriage
3. Passport of the applicant with photocopy of the passport's data page
4. Original DFA authenticated birth certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)
5. Original DFA authenticated Certificate of No Marriage issued by PSA
6. Affidavit of Parental Consent executed by both parents (*required only for applicant between 18 to 21 years old*)
7. Affidavit of Parental Advice executed by both parents (*required only for applicants between 21 to 25 years old*)
